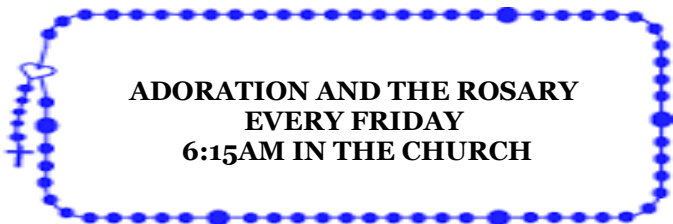

Monsignor's Corner

As a Church, we look forward to the upcoming Synod on the Family in the Fall. The following reflection might be helpful.

Pope Francis (*The Joy of the Gospel*): "This involves not only recognizing and discerning spirits, but also—and this is decisive—choosing movements of the spirit of good and rejecting those of the spirit of evil. (#51) Humanity is experiencing a turning point in its history. We can only praise the steps being taken in health care, education and communication. At the same time we have to remember that the majority of our contemporaries are barely living from day to day, with dire consequences. (#52)" (more to follow)
