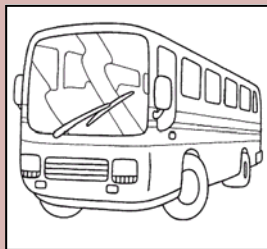

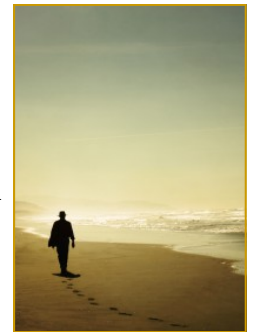

Monsignor's Corner

As a Church, we look forward to the upcoming Synod on the Family in the Fall. The following reflection might be helpful.



Pope Francis (*The Joy of the Gospel*): "Just as the commandment 'Thou shalt not kill' sets a clear limit in order to safeguard the value of human life, today we also have to say 'thou shalt not' to an economy of exclusion and inequality . . . How can it be that it is not a news item when an elderly homeless person dies of exposure, but it is news when the stock market loses two points? (#53). The culture of prosperity deadens us; we are thrilled if the market offers us something new to purchase . . . and in the meantime compassion at the outcry of the poor, others' pain, a need for help is someone else's responsibility and not our own. (#54)"
