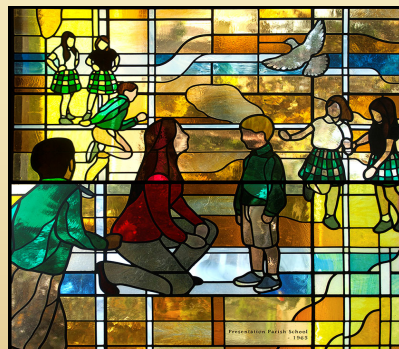

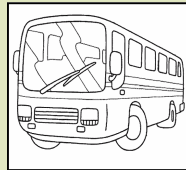

Monsignor's Corner

Recently the Italian bishops gathered in the Vatican for their annual meeting. The bishop of Rome offered them the following thoughts:

Francis asked the bishops to reinforce the "indispensable role" of ordinary folk in their dioceses.

He told them to stop acting as "pilots" telling the faithful what to do. "In reality, lay people who have an authentic Christian formation shouldn't need a bishop-pilot, or a monsignor-pilot, or clerical input to assume their responsibilities at every level, from political to social, economic to legislative," he said.
