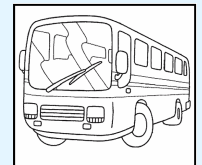
PLANNING A WEDDING at Presentation Church?

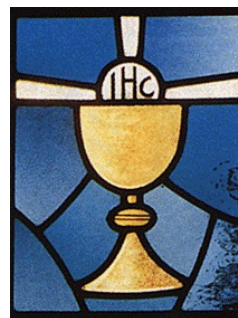
PRESENTATION SENIORS: JOIN US

Recently the Italian bishops gathered in the Vatican for their annual meeting. The bishop of Rome offered them the following thoughts:

Pope Francis complained that often official church documents are too heavy on doctrine and theory “as if our orientation isn't aimed at our people and country, but rather students and specialists.”

Francis has complained about an over-emphasis on doctrine and “small-minded rules” and lamented that theologians get in the way of evangelization; make sure your documents are concrete and comprehensible.
